

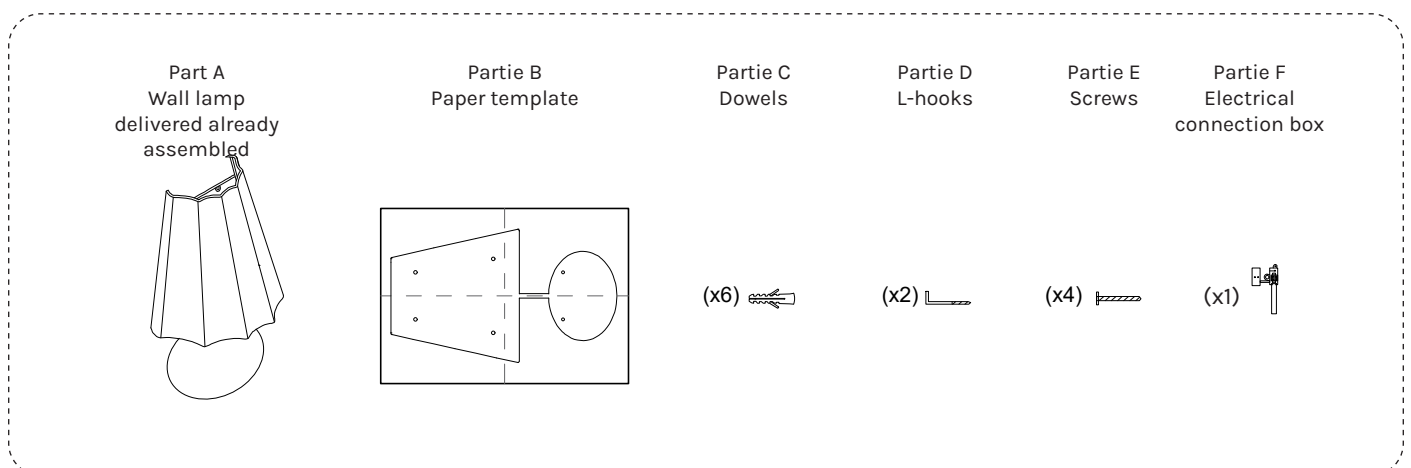
How to install your new light :

Please check that you received all of the components pictured in this guide. Reach out to us if anything is missing.

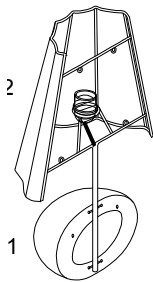
CAUTION :

Electrical shock risk. Turn off electrical power at the main fuse box or circuit panel before beginning installation, servicing the luminaire, or installing accessories.

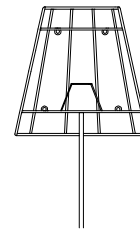
We recommend working with a qualified electrician familiar with the type of work you'd like done.



Description part A Part A is made up of a glazed stoneware base (A.1) fixed to a lampshade (A.2) in which an E27 socket (A.3) is installed.

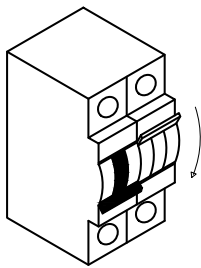

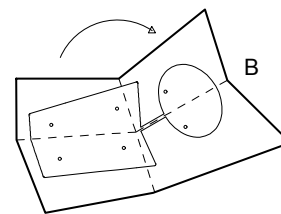

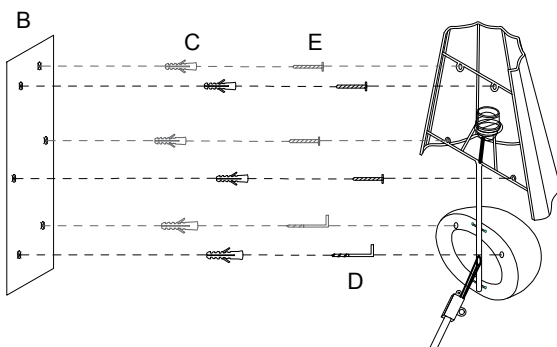
Step 1 Turn off electrical power at the main fuse box or electrical panel before beginning installation.



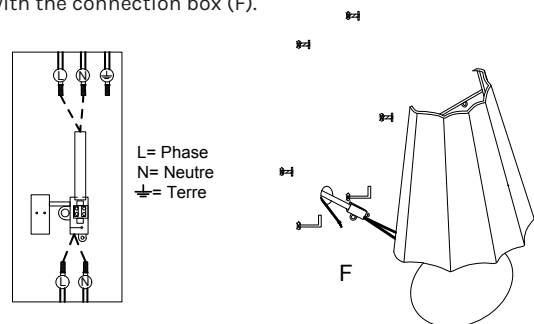
Step 2 Unfold the template (B) then place it on the wall to know where to position the hooks (D) and screws (E).



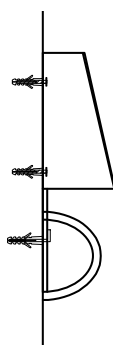
Step 3 Drill the holes in the wall then position the hooks (D) and the screws (E).



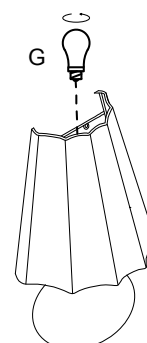
Step 4 Make the electrical connection between the L and N wires of the wall and the L and N wires of the wall light (A) with the connection box (F).



Step 5 Hang the lamp on the wall.



Step 6 Screw the E27 bulb to the socket.



Instruction for cleaning

How to clean your lamp

Unplug the lamp from the outlet before performing any cleaning operation. In the case of ceiling or wall lamps, make sure the switch is off.

Stoneware and jute twine lamp

To recover the original whiteness of biscuit porcelain, it should be cleaned with a soft damp sponge in lukewarm water with a mild detergent. You can gently dust the jute twine with a feather duster.

Good to know

Use an opal light bulb, if you want a uniform and diffuse light distribution.

Sold separately

Light bulb sold separately. EBUR recommends the E27 LED light bulb a maximum power of 10w.
